A Proud History Based On Innovation

Read our timeline to discover some of our most important moments stretching over the last 200 years.



1798

Joseph Lancaster founded a school in Borough Road, Southwark, which later became Borough Road College in 1817.



1928

Acton Technical College was founded. In 1957 part of it became Brunel College of Technology which pioneered the concept of 'sandwich' courses.



1966

After being awarded the Royal Charter, Brunel College of Advanced Technology became Brunel University.



1980

Brunel merged with Shoreditch College of Education, one of the leading teacher training colleges in craft, design and technology.

1878

Maria Grey College was founded and later moved to the Twickenham campus.



1889

Shoreditch Training College was founded and later moved to the Runnymede campus.



1962

Brunel College became a College of Advanced Technology and started making plans to move to a 170-acre plot in Uxbridge.



1968

The official Opening Ceremony was held on the University's new campus.





1986

Brunel opened Britain's first University Science Park on campus; which gave local SME's the opportunity to work collaboratively with academics.



2011

The Institute of the Environment, won the Queen's Anniversary Prize for Higher Education for their research revealing the link between chemicals in rivers and reproductive health.



2022

Brunel Medical School welcomed their first Medicine MBBS cohort. This exciting new 5-year undergraduate degree incorporates modern evidence-based approaches to learning.

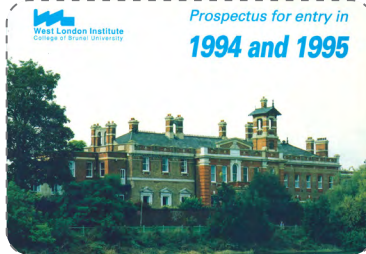
1983

Brunel University London officially joins the University of London federation.

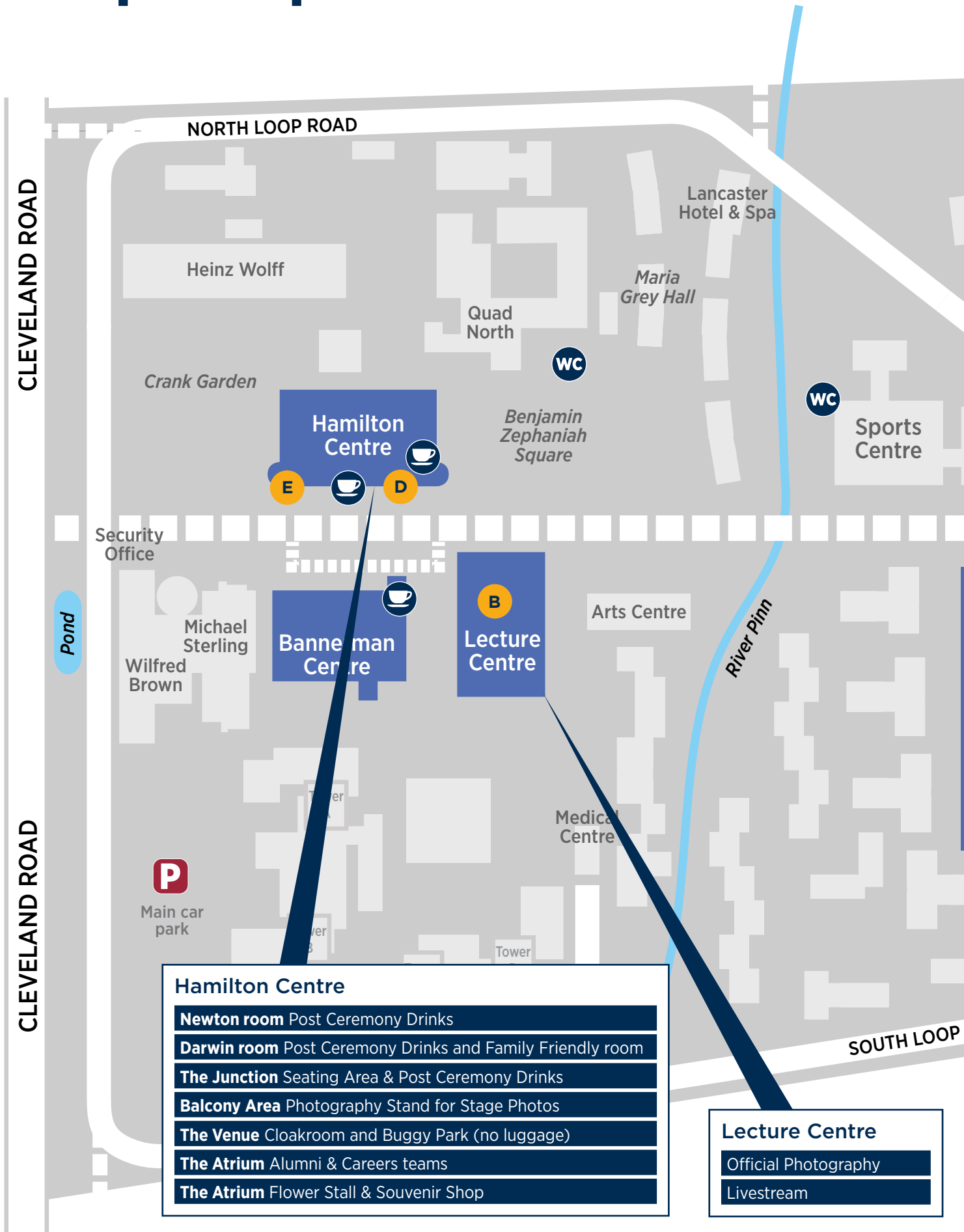

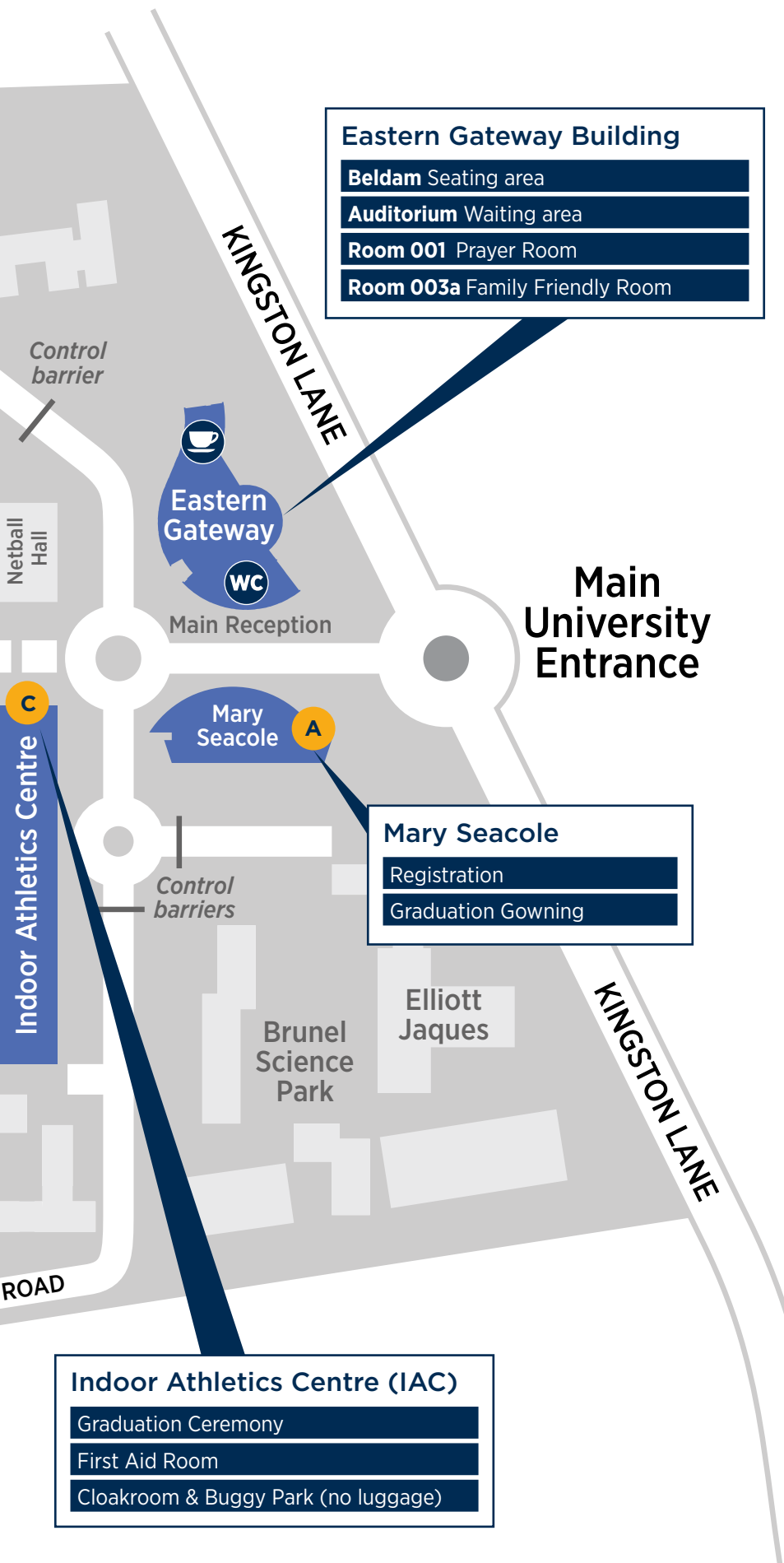

Order of Events

Your awards ceremony is a memorable occasion and gives you the perfect opportunity to celebrate your achievements with family, friends and fellow students. Here's a short overview of what happens during this special event.

Opening the ceremony

It begins with the congregation being asked to stand as the Academic Procession enters. It includes:

- Academic Staff
- Registrar
- Union representative
- Heads of Department
- Pro Vice-Chancellors
- Honorary Fellow and/or Graduate
- Vice-Chancellor and President
- Mace Bearer
- Pro-Rector

The Mace Bearer enters and places the University Mace, a symbol of the University's authority under its Royal Charter on its stand. The Pro-Rector declares the congregation open and everyone is seated.

Following this, our Vice-Chancellor welcomes the congregation.

Presentation of awards

Once the ceremony officially opens, the presentation of awards begins. Each student's name is presented by the Head of Department or by one of their senior academic colleagues to the Pro-Rector and Vice-Chancellor. On receiving their award, the student becomes a graduate. During the ceremony, a representative from the class graduating will give a student speech.



Hoarding Ceremony

During the ceremony, the PhD student has the option of kneeling on a leather and wooden kneeling stool called a Pew.

Our Vice-Chancellor then places the doctoral hood over their head, signifying their accomplishment in being awarded a doctorate.

Honorary Degrees and Fellowships

During the presentation, awards for Honorary Degrees and Honorary Fellowships are given to individuals the University wishes to honour. Continue reading our programme to find out who's been awarded.

Prize winners

The Vice-Chancellor's Prizes for Doctoral Research are awarded on the basis of research excellence supported by research papers or other output.

Closing the ceremony

The Pro-Rector will declare the ceremony closed and invite everyone to stand for the National Anthem. The Mace Bearer picks up the Mace and leads the procession out of the theatre. The congregation stands until the Academic Procession and graduates have left.

Degree classifications

These ceremonies are an opportunity to celebrate the achievements of all students, therefore individual degree classifications are not shown in the programme or identified during the ceremony.

1965 VC Gown



In 1965 Ede and Ravenscroft were appointed the University's official robe makers. They designed a gown and mortarboard for Dr James Topping, the first Vice-Chancellor of the University. Today our current Vice-Chancellor, Professor Andrew Jones wears a replica of the same gown and mortarboard in line with the university's heritage, symbolising continuity and a connection with the foundation of our history.



Graduation gowns

Brunel's formal gown colours are taken from the red and blue of the University's logo. You will notice that members of the procession wear a wide range of different coloured gowns, as it is tradition to wear the gown awarded by the institution they received their highest academic qualification.



Diploma / Cert

For those who have completed a shorter course at either undergraduate or postgraduate level, such as Postgraduate Certificate in Education.



Undergraduate

For those who are due to graduate with an undergraduate degree. Also referred to as a bachelor's degree.



Postgraduate

For those who are due to graduate with a higher-level degree, usually referred to as a Postgraduate or Master's degree.



Doctorate

For those who have completed a doctoral degree, usually referred to as a PhD, and earned the title of Doctor. This is the highest academic rank formally awarded at a degree ceremony.

Pro-Rectors act as the ceremonial figureheads of the University. They are external members and not University staff. They preside at Degree Congregations, conferring degrees and present other awards granted by the University, maintaining an important ambassadorial role to represent the University in the external community.

Council is the governing body of the University. It mostly consists of independent members, each of whom serve up to four years. The Chair of Council leads these members to monitor the work of the University. The Chair of Council has delegated authority to preside over the graduation ceremonies and shares this task with the Pro-Rectors.

Pro-Rectors



John Cridland CBE

Chairman of the Home Group, John Cridland's former roles include Chairman of Transport for the North, a Board member of Ofsted, and a visiting Professor of University College London. He has served on the Low Pay Commission, ACAS Council, the CBI, and Business in the Community and was a UK Commissioner for Employment and Skills. Awarded a CBE for services to business in 2006, John received an honorary doctorate from Brunel in 2015 and became a Pro-Rector two years later.



Dr Shini Somara

Dr Shini Somara is a mechanical engineer specialising in Computational Fluid Dynamics and an award-winning media broadcaster and producer. She delves into Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM) and innovation to deliver easily accessible and relatable pearls of wisdom for all ages and abilities. Her aim is to translate complex and technical subjects into accessible formats for everyone. She speaks to audiences on TV and radio and through live events, has published seven children's STEM books, and runs podcasts for Women in STEM and for innovators. Her drive is to democratise STEM to encourage more diversity and inclusion and widening participation amongst our future scientists, engineers and innovators. In addition to having presented for broadcasters such as the BBC, Al Jazeera and Sky, she has delivered talks at the United Nations and TEDx. She is a trustee of the Global Communications Museum and is a Blue Plaques Panel member for English Heritage. She studied at Brunel as both an undergraduate and a doctoral researcher, and also was conferred as an Honorary Doctor of Science in 2023.

Chair of Council



Stuart Palmer

Stuart Palmer is an Emeritus Professor at the University of Warwick. His BSc and PhD were in Physics at the University of Sheffield after which he took up a lectureship in the Applied Physics Department at the University of Hull. He left Hull for the Chair in Experimental Physics at the University of Warwick initially as Head of the Physics Department, then Pro Vice-Chancellor for Research and finally Provost and Deputy Vice-Chancellor. He has chaired and served on a wide range of committees for HEFCE and EPSRC. His research has spanned Condensed Matter Physics, Medical Physics and Non-destructive Evaluation and he has supervised more than 50 PhD students. His research led to the formation of three spin-out companies in conjunction with research students and the ultrasonic investigation of osteoporosis was recognised by the naming of a train on the East Coast Main Line the 'Professor Stuart Palmer'. More recently he has chaired the Council of Cardiff University for six years and was Visiting Professor at Queensland University of Technology and is now the Honorary Treasurer of the European Physical Society.

In 2008 Vijay's father suffered a stroke, impacting the entire family unit and changing their day to day lives. Unable to find support, Vijay quit her job to become a full-time carer for her father and during this time she noticed the positive impact of yoga on his recovery. Motivated, Vijay earned a Level 1 Yoga qualification, and in 2010, Hounslow Council asked her to create a stroke survivors' exercise class. Partnering with Different Strokes, she now runs two weekly classes at Brunel and Hounslow, offering Zumba, Yoga, Tai Chi, and Talk and Laughter Therapy. Designed to meet members' diverse needs, her classes attract over 40 regular participants and have a growing membership of over 150 members. Vijay's dedication ensures that stroke survivors and their families feel supported and connected, and she hopes to expand these Active Group Classes nationwide.

Julie co-founded OxStem Neuro, a pioneering drug discovery company focused on degenerative disorders. Her influential work helped secure over £17 million in funding. Joining GE Healthcare in 2019, she managed cross-functional oncology projects, evaluated partnerships, and led nonclinical due diligence. During the pandemic, Julie spearheaded research linking neuropilin-1 to COVID-19 symptoms. In 2022, Julie became the Global Head of Nonclinical Development at GE Healthcare, she drives strategic growth and oversees R&D portfolio milestones.



Rising Star Award

Dr Sahil Datta (MSc Advanced Electronic & Electrical Engineering, 2016. PhD Electronics and Computer Engineering Research, 2021)

Sahil's dedication to improve healthcare led him to co-found PsychoTec, where he is actively involved in developing AI-assisted solutions for mental health diagnosis and intervention. In November 2023, Moses was honoured with the Forty Under 40 UK for Video Production.

Chidumaga founded EXERGIE, a Clean Energy business in 2021 and has spearheaded initiatives that have propelled the company to the forefront of the industry, from the famous National Stadium Squash Courts Lagos Project (N.S.S.C) to health sector medical diagnostic labs. In 2023, Chidumaga expanded EXERGIE's registered presence into Sierra Leone. In just two years, EXERGIE facilitated the installation of over 2,500KW of solar electricity, generating approx 3,832.5MWh of clean energy while reducing carbon emissions.

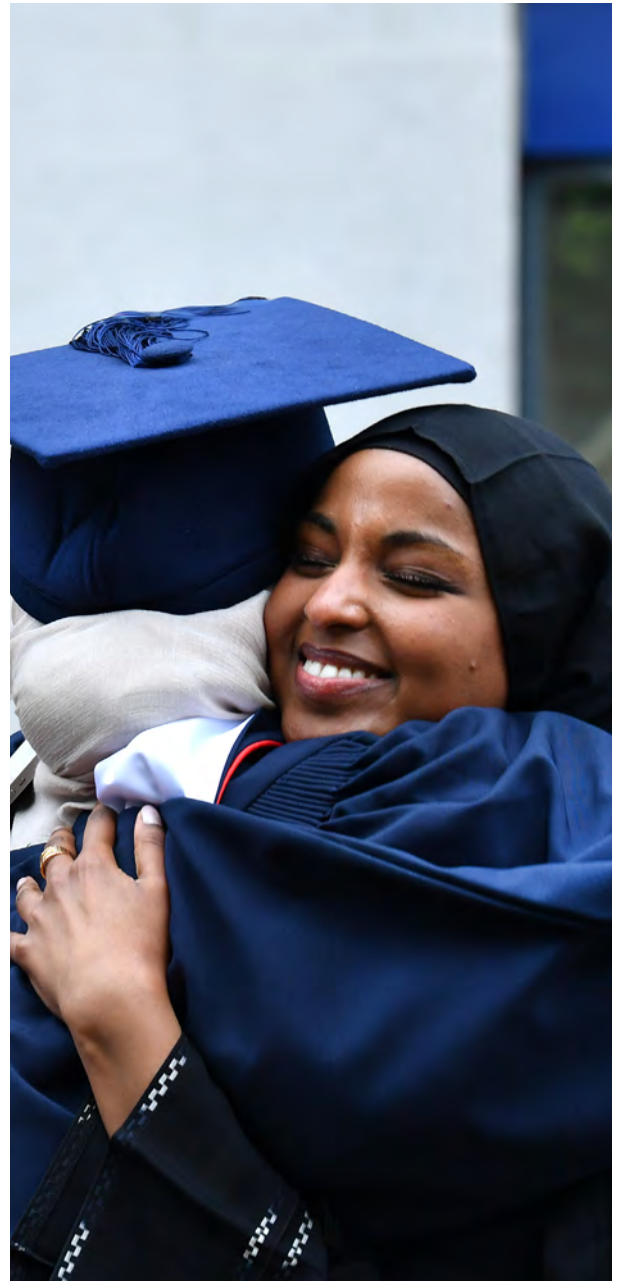

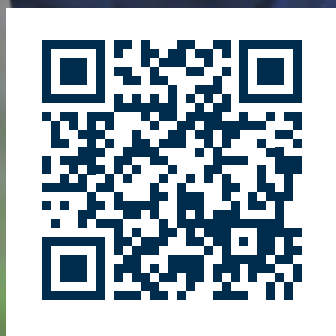
