Grade Translation Procedure

1 Introduction

- 1.1 Students who spend part of their degree abroad at an approved partner institution on an exchange, and formally undertake modules with that partner institution, will have their achieved grades converted to Brunel University London's grading system, so that they may be applied to their degree grade profile. At FHEQ levels 5 and 6, and for Masters programmes, these converted grades will typically contribute to the student's degree classification.
- 1.2 The translation of partner institution grading schemes is overseen by University Education Committee, and the process for this is presented under Section 2 of this Procedure.
- 1.3 Approved grade translation tables are presented under Appendix 1

2 Guidance on Translating Grades

- 2.1 In order to translate another institution's grades to Brunel's, staff should be in possession of the partner institution's grading scheme, which will typically include a numerical range and descriptors.
- 2.2 Staff should check if, within the partner institution, subject or department specific grading schemes do not take priority over the institution's generic grading scheme.
- 2.3 When comparing grading schemes, staff should consider the following:
 - The alignment of the partner's descriptor with that of Brunel.
 - The specific grade used by the partner as the pass threshold, as the terminology may not explicitly confirm that
 - Whether or not a one to one mapping is not possible, and only a single grade (B) as opposed to B- and B+ can be mapped.

3 Procedure for Approval of Grade Translation

- 3.1 Where the requirement for grade translation has been identified, the relevant member of academic staff within the associated department will complete the Grade Translation Table Request form available [here](#), and submit it to quality-officers@brunel.ac.uk for scrutiny and approval by University Education Committee.
- 3.2 Following scrutiny and approval of the request for grade translation, which may require liaison between University Education Committee and the relevant

member of academic staff; and, potentially, contact with the partner/host institution, the approved grade translation table will be incorporated into Appendix 1 of this Procedure.

4 Application of Grade Translation to Student Grade Profiles

- 4.1 At the point at which a student's ratified grade from their host institution is available, application of the relevant grade translation table will be undertaken by the relevant member of academic staff, typically the academic exchange coordinator, and using the Grade Translation Block Exemption and Grade Importation Form available [here](#).
- 4.3 Completed Block Exemption and Grade Important forms should be submitted to the Awards Team via awards-staff@brunel.ac.uk (copying in exchanges@brunel.ac.uk) who enter the grade and details of where it was obtained into the student's profile in SITS,
