Purpose

To convey the Safety and Security issues around the use of Security Bollards around campus.

Definition

A Security Bollard is any fixed or movable pillar which is in place to segregate specific areas for the control of traffic.

Application

The policy shall apply to all the users of the Brunel University Campus whether staff or contactors.

Policy

The bollard shall be secured by a padlock and be removable by one person. It must be of a height of around 1m and be marked with highly reflective marking tape visible at night. It must have a secondary storage socket to prevent theft and make the lifting operation easier and remove the risk of tripping. It must not be of the form that lowers in to or onto the ground as if damaged slightly these will not function correctly as well as causing a potential trip hazard when lowered or folded.
