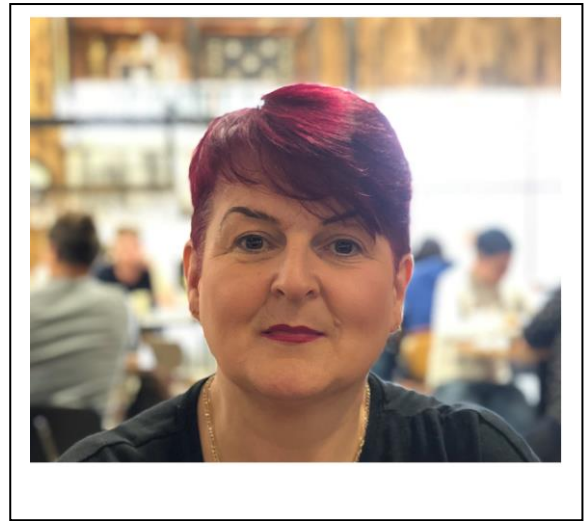

The subscriptions are based on your earnings and on a sliding scale to help our members on the lowest grades and salaries. We represent members, negotiate and bargain on their behalf and campaign for better working conditions and pay and for public services.

Nationally, UNISON is actively campaigning to:

- Protect public services
- Improve pay and conditions and end low pay
- Promote fairness and equality

Locally, we defend and support members facing reorganisation or redundancy, and offer advice and representation on issues at work.
